1 American Reunion

STARRING: Jason Bigg, Alyson Hannigan, and Seann William Scott


DIRECTOR(S): Jon Hurwitz and Hayden Schlossberg

PLOT: Jim, his wife Michelle, and the rest of the gang from American Pie prepare for their High School reunion in East Great Falls, Michigan. This film is sure to offer audiences with the same heavy level of innuendo and sexual hijinks that the rest of the films in the series have put forth. While the original American Pie (1999) and the sequel of the same name from 2001 were legitimate box office successes with somewhat original formulas, the over-saturation of lesser spin-offs like American Pie Presents: The Naked Mile (2006) and American Pie Presents: Beta House (2007), have only stood to cheapen the series. By bringing the original cast back in addition to Jon Hurwitz's style from the similar but slightly fresher Harold and Kumar series, American Reunion has a real shot at reminding audiences why they fell in love with these horny teenagers in the first place.

2 Mirror Mirror

STARRING: Julia Roberts, Lily Collins, and Armie Hammer

PLOT: In a modern-take on the classic fairytale, Snow White is banished to a dark forest by an evil queen who wants to take over the kingdom. As she grows into a strong young woman, she befriends seven dwarves and fights to save her country. Because of its PG rating, this film seems to be aimed more towards families and young children despite Singh's experience with more mature and gritty films like Immortals (2011) and The Cell (2000). It may be hard for audiences to believe Roberts' performance as the evil queen due to her long track record as America's sweetheart. The pressure then, turns to the screenplay. If the writers are able to achieve an even balance between the fairytale's original rebellious spirit and a fun, comedic atmosphere, Mirror Mirror will allow audiences to enjoy reflecting back on a childhood favorite.
